Car Parking Permits ó a new year means a new parking permit! If you would like to renew / apply for a permit to use St Teresaøs Hall car park and the church car park outside of service times please:

- Put your name and car registration number on an envelope
- Enclose a cheque for £17.50 made payable to -RC Church Sidmouthø
- Post the envelope through the presbytery door

NB these permits allow use of the car parks outside of service times; you do **not** need a permit if you are attending a church service. Please also remember that these permits do not give anyone the automatic right to park, but the facility to park if a space is available, and that there is **no overnight parking** unless specifically agreed. *Thank you.*
