Did you know that we have a **St Vincent de Paul (SVP)** group in the parish? Fifteen parishioners and a translator volunteer visit 17 housebound people on a regular basis, most of whom are parishioners. We also maintain contact with a further 15 parishioners to check they are coping. We visit in pairs to chat, help sort out worries, or do a little shopping or other errands. At times we act as advocates with care providers or Social Services. We are separate from but work with our Eucharistic Ministers to continue to provide ongoing support. Our work owes its inspiration to both St Vincent de Paul and Blessed Frederick and we are part of the Vincentian Family. On **27**th **September**, the feast of St Vincent, the Mass intention is for our twin Vincentian Conference in Kerala. If you have time perhaps you could join us to pray for their fantastic work in India.
